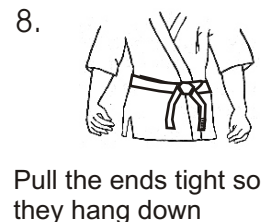
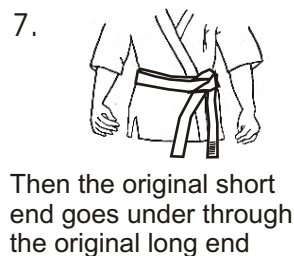
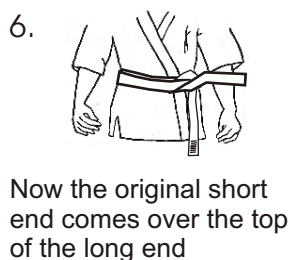
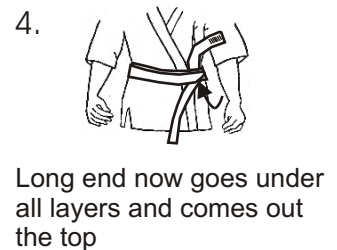
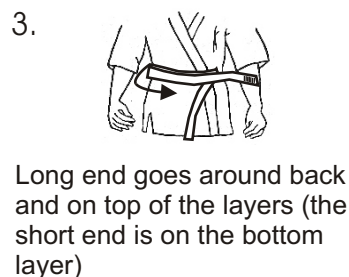
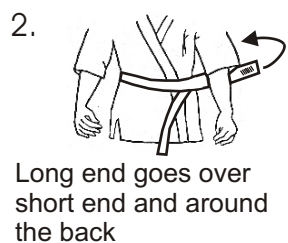
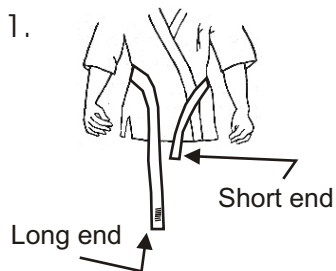
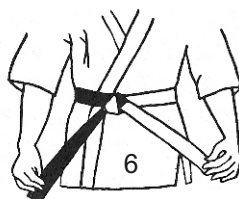
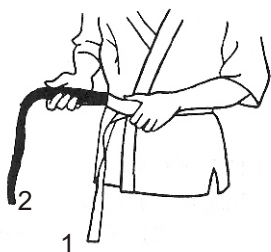


## Tying a Belt for Someone (From the Front)



## Tying Your Own Belt



1. Start on the right side, leaving a tail for the knot.
2. Wrap the belt around twice.
3. Take the top layer and tuck it under all of the layers from bottom to top.
4. Pull the tail currently sticking out of the top down and to the right.
5. Take the tail you left for tying the knot and put it through the loop you just made with the other tail.
6. Tighten the belt - both ends should be about the same length and hang down at an angle.
